## Governor Murphy puts 4th <u>FULL</u> Pension Payment in the 2024-2025 Budget

Governor Murphy has proposed yet another record pension payment in the 2025 budget year, with \$7.2 billion slated for the state-funded pension systems.

This the Murphy Administration's 4th consecutive FULL pension payment – he is the first governor to fully fund the pension in over 25 years.

This will bring Governor Murphy's total to over \$39 billion since he took office in 2018.

Elections matter! Had Governor Murphy continued the on path of past governors, making either no payment or a partial payment, the system was at risk of not having enough to pay out benefits. And full payments matter! Unless we get a full payment every year, the system continues to be at risk and retirees will continue to not receive a cost-of-living adjustment (COLA).


